Club History

The Supervisors' Club was organized through the efforts of a group of supervisors who wanted a place to meet outside of the work environment. The Club offers various opportunities for all salaried Waterloo Works employees to expand current and extend new relationships with fellow employees in a social atmosphere outside of work.

The Supervisors' Club schedules several social events throughout the year including gourmet meals, dances, family breakfasts, and parties. The Club is available on Friday nights for members and their guests with hot sandwiches available and drink specials. The Club also sponsors a member Pool League on Friday nights throughout the Fall and Winter months. The Supervisors' Club is available for members to use the bar, dining and dancing facilities at a discounted rate for wedding receptions, anniversaries, retirements, class reunions, birthdays, etc.

Business Meetings

The Club schedules four to five business meetings each year, which are open only to members. The night consists of a social hour, free dinner, speaker, and a business meeting. During these meetings, members are afforded the opportunity to propose new Club business, vote on pending issues, listen to guest speakers, and discuss items of interest with other members. The second business meeting each fall offers each member the opportunity to bring a spouse with them to enjoy a free meal and listen to the speaker.

Fees

The annual membership fee of \$95 is free for new members until dues are collected in April & May. Fees are used for improvements to the Club, utilities, taxes, licenses, and other expense incurred through the club. All dues are obtained through payroll deduction and are taken care of by the club. Also, as part of your membership, there are volunteer crews that members may choose to work for. Volunteering is no longer required, however, it is still appreciated and volunteers will be rewarded throughout the year with special events at the Club. These volunteer opportunities are excellent ways to meet other members as well as keep Supervisors' Club costs down. Ask any of our members that do volunteer and they will tell you volunteering is a very rewarding experience!

Lifetime Members

Active members who retire from Company services are presented a Lifetime Membership at a reduced cost of \$50.00 providing they were members of the Club at retirement.
