







September & October Recap

A holiday tip....

As the holidays are nearing, so is that time of year where you dig through box after box in the storage room to find all your ornaments to decorate your house. After hours of decorating you find that you have lost some from one year to the next, making your tree seem a bit empty. Looking outside, the snow looks dreadful and less than appealing to go out in just for some holiday décor. What now?

Making your own ornaments can be the perfect stay-in, family night. All you need are a couple of those books you don't want anymore, some scissors, a few rings and ribbon to hang your new wreath ornament.

Step 1: Find a few pages from an old book that you wouldn't mind cutting

Step 2: Sketch a circular line to guide where you will cut

Step 3: Cut along your line to create a curly cue

Step 4: Stretch out the paper you've just cut



Step 5-7: Roll the paper up into small circles. Glue in various spots as you are rolling

Step 8: Glue the circles onto your ring. Once the whole ring is covered, place a ribbon at the top

Step 9: Hang on your tree! (You can also make this into a larger wreath!)
