Greetings Fellow Members,

As we rapidly approach the month of March and the transfer of the President's gavel, I decided to write at least one article for the newsletter (with some prodding from the staff). **To start, a sincere thanks for the support I have received this past year as President:** the board for their willingness to contribute their time and wisdom, the staff for their energy and devotion, and the membership for their participation and support. This past year we have continued on our capital improvement plan with some major improvements including new carpeting, a new HVAC system, an energy efficient water heater, and a new fireplace to name a few. We have focused our spending on critical infrastructure needs as well as aesthetic improvements which help market the Club for the rental events which in turn fund a majority of the Club improvements.
